- Save the file into the "Document" (you can save to the D: drive for optional)
- Save as the "host.txt"

• Click "..." then select "Options"

- In the Folder Options, make sure you uncheck the "Hide extensions for known file types"
- Click OK

- Go the save directory (Documents)
- Right click at the host.txt then select "Rename"

- Modify the file name from "hosts.txt" to "hosts" (remove .txt)
- Click "Yes"







• Right click at the hosts file then select "Copy"



Paste file



- Back to the folder "C:\Windows\System32\drivers\etc"
- Right click at the empty space then select "paste"
- Select "Replace the file in the destination"
- Select "Continue"
